Dr B Ashok IAS, the Principal Secretary & Agricultural Production Commissioner of the Agriculture Development and Farmer's Welfare Department, Government of Kerala is an eminent educationist, writer, speaker, academician, and columnist. Currently holding additional charge as the Vice Chancellor of Kerala Agricultural University, he was also the first Vice-Chancellor of the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University established by the Govt. of Kerala.

A 1998 batch IAS officer, he served as the Director, Central Department of Agriculture; Deputy Director, National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie and faculty of Mussoorie IAS Academy over 15 years. He also held the posts of Energy Secretary, Chairman and Managing Director of the Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB), and the Director of Water Resource Department. During his tenure as Chairman and Managing Director of KSEB, he had initiated many revolutionary reforms.

He holds a bachelor's degree in veterinary science from the University of Agriculture, a master's degree in water resources from the University of London, and a master's degree in political science from the University of Turin, Italy. In 2019, he won Canada's prestigious international research award for Sociology Research Dissertation. He received training in Management from TATA Management School India, University of London and Duke University, USA. He has also published many books including the one on the history of veterinary science, academic papers, and more than a thousand articles. He is currently the President of the Kerala IAS Officer's Association.
